

May 26, 2010 Platform Cleanup Day

The platform cleanup day went very well. Six of us were able to clean and cut back poison ivy and other vines on the triple platforms at Cypress Woods and the double platforms at Bear Garden. We also cleaned off the platforms with brooms and a blower and collected enough trash to fill up a garbage bag.



We were not able to go to the double platforms at Mill Creek today but we have a plan for that soon.

Also, we are trying to get a work group together as soon as possible



to put a roof on both “outhouses” at Cypress Woods and Bear Garden so the rain doesn't fill them up. They are both full because of the rain water. Even if folks remember to close the lid the rain still gets in. We think a roof is the only answer to preventing this from happening. Also we are arranging to have these “outhouses” pumped out as soon as possible.

We also retrieved a number of surveys from the platforms that we will pass on to the Albemarle Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) Council.
